RFP for Four Laning of Munger to Mirzachauki (NH-80) section from Rasulpur to Mirzachauki Design Chainage Km157+350 to Km193+931 (Package 04) on Hybrid Annuity mode in the state of Bihar

The Government of India had entrusted to the Authority the development, maintenance and management of National Highway No. 80 including the section from Km 157+350 to km 193+931 (Design Chainage) (approx. Design Length 36.562 Km). The Authority had resolved construct from Rasulpur to Mirzachauki section of NH-80 from Design Chainage Km. 157+350 to Km. 193+931 (Package-4) in the State of Bihar by Four-Laning thereof (the "Project") on design, build, operate and transfer (the "DBOT Annuity" or "Hybrid Annuity" basis, and has decided to carry out the bidding process for selection of a private entity as the Bidder to whom the Project may be awarded.
